An SRIP team consisting of classroom teacher(s), intervention teacher(s), and administrator/designee will meet monthly to review progress. The librarian, computer lab teacher, counselor, and EL teacher will attend as needed. It is important for our team to finalize and begin implementing the plan to help your child become a successful reader. If the reading deficiency isn't addressed by the end of third grade, your child may not be promoted to fourth grade unless a good cause exemption is satisfied as outlined in the Alabama Literacy Act. While the statewide reading assessment is the initial determinant for promotion, it isn't the only option. Students may also participate in a "test-based student portfolio and an alternative reading assessment option to demonstrate sufficient reading skills for promotion to fourth grade". We look forward to working with you to help your child become a lifelong successful reader.
