

Afterschool Reopening Plan

When do you expect to reopen?

Afterschool programs will begin two weeks after students return on-site or at a date specified by the principal. A separate registration will be required. <u>Any past afterschool balances must be zeroed out before registering.</u>

Parents should take students' temperatures before sending them to school. Parents should not send students to school if they are showing symptoms of Co-vid 19.

What steps are you going to take to protect my child's health and well-being when you reopen?

Afterschool programs will initially accept 32 students for a 1:8 ratio. K-5 programs will randomly select five Kindergarten, 5 first Graders, 5 second graders, 5 third graders, 5 fourth graders, 5 fifth graders. Two additional registered students will be randomly selected. Middle and High school programs will randomly select students. A wait list will be created.

After two weeks the student number will be increased to 40 students for a 1:10 ratio. Students at each of the three levels will be randomly selected from the wait list.

Two weeks later the student number will be increased to 60 students for a 1:15 ratio. Students at each of the three levels will be randomly selected from the wait list.

Consideration will be made for siblings attending the same school and feeder school.

Students' temperatures will be taken before entering the afterschool area by the afterschool staff and nurses (school nurses will be on-site from 3:05 to 3:35 until Dec. 15). Students having a temperature over 100.4 will be relocated to a designated isolation area.

Follow school procedures requiring second – twelfth grade students to wear masks at all times.

Students will be reasonably social distanced.

Students will have individual supplies which will be sanitized daily.

All afterschool areas will be sanitized daily.

An isolation area will be identified and equipped with the same monitoring device used in the schools.

Each site will have a buzzer and monitor so parents won't have to come in the facility.

What steps are the schools taking to protect my child's health and wellbeing when you reopen the afterschool program?

Students' temperatures will be taken before entering the afterschool area by the afterschool staff and nurses (school nurses will be on-site from 3:05 to 3:35 until Dec. 15). Students having a temperature over 100.4 will be relocated to a designated isolation area.



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Classrooms will release afterschool students last so the appropriate number of staff is present.

Principals will allow school staff working in the afterschool program to be in their place by 3:05.

Principals will continue recording faculty meetings so the certified afterschool staff won't miss out on important information.

Follow school procedures set for third party enrichment providers.

Outside staff and enrichment providers will have their temperature taken before entering the program.

What will be available when you reopen?

Students will be provided a snack and a drink Homework help will be available Initially, enrichment activities will be provided virtually Academic enrichment will support the school's pacing guides.
