JOB OUTLOOK

Job opportunities for automotive technicians are expected to be good for persons who complete automotive training programs in high school, technical schools, and community colleges. Most persons who enter the automotive occupation may expect steady work because changes in economic conditions have little effect on the automotive repair business. Top automotive technicians can expect to earn from \$40,000 to \$60,000 per year.



WHAT IS AUTOMOTIVE SERVICE TECHNOLOGY?

This course provides classroom and laboratory experiences in current and emerging technology in automotive service theory and repair. It includes training in the use of computer and other electronic diagnostic and testing equipment, technical manuals, and problem-solving methods. Instruction and practice will be given in safety, diagnosis of malfunctions, and disassembly of system components, parts inspections and repair of electrical and electronic systems, brake systems, engine performance, and steering and suspension systems. Particular emphasis is given to the use of decision-making and problemsolving techniques in applying science, mathematics, communication, and social studies concepts to solve technological problems. Instruction and training are provided in the proper care, use and maintenance of tools and equipment and all applicable local state, and federal safety and environmental regulations.

After completing two or three years in auto tech at GCHS/Career Tech you will need to complete a one or two year program at a technical or junior college.
