Seed: Durana clover, chicory, turnips, winter rye grass Fee: \$30 (includes seed + materials for an exclusion cage)

Plot Visit by Extension Staff: December 2018/January 2019

Awards + Prize Money: Banquet in May 2019

#### **Rules and Regulations:**

- 1) Youth **9-18 years old as of 1 January 2019** are eligible to participate.
- 2) Participants must have access to at least 1/2 acre of land to plant.
- 3) To start the project, each participant will need to pick-up a soil sample box at the Etowah County Extension Office.
- 4) Records MUST be shown at the culmination of the project in the form of an Achievement Portfolio. Youth will receive this documentation at the mandatory meeting.
  - When the seed was planted, crop yield, amount of rainfall, wildlife sightings, expenses, etc... (please include creative documentation such as pictures)
