D. Reports

1. Windy Van Hooten - Garden Gnomie

Jonathan and Becca Gardner presented to the board the Windy Van Hooten Teaching Garden. The garden is an educational outdoor classroom designed to engage students in the full cycle of growing food by planting, tending, and harvesting. Currently, Adams Elementary, Eura Brown Elementary and Striplin Elementary are participating in the full program. An after school program is located at Adams, Eura Brown, Striplin, Floyd, Mitchell, Walnut Park and Donehoo Elementary Schools.

2. COVID Update

Superintendent Reddick reported the system has had 287 cumulative COVID cases from the 5289 enrollment, including staff and students. There are currently 32 active

cases, which is .6% of the total enrollment. The threshold for considering a change in our instructional plan is 5%.

Superintendent Reddick also reported both Mid-South Band Festival and Gadsden City High School went well. No financials have been submitted for review from Mid-South, but felt the day was a very successful day. The festival introduced the Steve Reagan Award for outstanding band performance. Homecoming was a great success, with only a few hang ups with the pace of parade. The door decorations were outstanding and the floats were amazing. The senior class won the float completion.
