YOUTH CAN CHOOSE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE FOLLOWING PLOT OPTION:



Cool Season Plot

Seed: Austrian winter peas, chicory, Durana clover, oats

Fee: \$40 (seed for a ½ acre plot and materials for an exclusion cage)

\$25 (past participants – seed for a ½ acre plot, no t-posts)

\$20 (per ½ acre of additional seed, if want a larger food plot)

Mandatory Meeting + Seed Pickup: September 2021

Plot Visit by Extension Staff: December 2021/January 2022

Awards: Based on number of participants

Rules and Regulations:

- 1) Youth **9-18 years old as of 1 January 2022** are eligible to participate.
- 2) Participants must have access to at least 1/2 acre of land to plant.
- 3) To start the project, each participant will need to pick-up a soil sample box at your local County Extension Office.
- 4) Records MUST be shown at the culmination of the project in the form of an Achievement Portfolio. Youth will receive this documentation at the mandatory meeting.
 - When the seed was planted, crop yield, amount of rainfall, wildlife sightings, expenses, etc... (please include creative documentation such as pictures)
