4-H Pig Squeal Project!

Etowah County

What is it?

The 4-H Pig Squeal project is designed to teach 4-H members recommended management practices for growing and raising swine. Your participation in the 4-H Pig Squeal project will help you:

- **Bevelop swine management skills**
- **&** Learn to produce healthy hogs
- Develop an awareness for business management
- Develop record keeping skills (income and expenses)
- **Realize the pride of accomplishment**

How the Pig Squeal project works:

In early January 2022, you will receive 2 feeder pigs that are approximately 60 days old and weigh approximately 50 pounds and are barrows (castrated males). They will all come from a reputable nursery and will be properly vaccinated. You will care for these pigs for approximately 120 days. At the end of this time, you will bring one of the hogs to the Northeast Alabama 4-H Pig Squeal Show and Sale (tentatively scheduled for end of April/beginning of May). At this time they will be shown and auctioned off with you receiving prize money and a portion of the auction proceeds. The auctioned hogs will be processed and picked up from the processor by the winning bidder. The bidder will not have to take possession of a live animal.

<u>How to participate:</u> In order to participate in the 4-H Pig Squeal project, follow these simple steps:

1. Fill out the registration form that is attached. Detach it and mail it along with your check for \$150.00 made out to the <u>Alabama 4-H Club</u> <u>Foundation</u> and mail to the Etowah County Extension Office, 3200-A West Meighan Blvd, Gadsden, AL 35904. Also, insure that your child is enrolled in 4-H for the 2021-2022 school year through v2.4honline.com. The registration form must be signed by both youth and a parent.

2. Both youth <u>and</u> a parent must come to a <u>mandatory</u> training on an evening in December. The time and place of this meeting will be announced after registration. At this meeting you will receive valuable information to help you prepare for and raise the pigs you will receive.

3. Pick up your 2 barrows in Sand Rock in January 2022. We will announce the time and date of pick-up closer to the pick-up date. Take them home and begin taking care of them. They will be given out on a first come, first serve basis.

4. During your project, you will be contacted by your Extension Office to schedule a home-visit during the months of March/April with one of our Extension Agents. This is a mandatory part of the project. Failure to complete a home-visit will result in disqualification from the show and sale at the end of the project.

5. At the beginning of the month of March, you will be given a packet at your home visit notifying you when and where the Northeast Alabama 4-H Pig Squeal Show and Sale will be held, along with the information that you need and 3 flyers. As part of your participation, you will be required to post these three flyers (or more) at various locations in your community inviting folks to come to the sale and to secure donations and buyers for the show and auction. After all, the more people that are there, the more money your pigs will bring!

6. Bring 1 barrow to the County Show and Sale and do your best!! The remaining barrow will be yours to keep, sell, or process.

<u>Who can participate?</u> Any young person between the ages of 9 and 18, as of January 1, 2022 who lives in or attends school in Etowah County is eligible to take part. You do not have to be a current 4-H member to participate; however, you will need to enroll via v2.4honline.com if you are not a current 4-H member.

<u>Note:</u> The number of participants will be limited this year due to the lack of processors available. When 15 participants have registered, those that submit their form following this will be placed on a waiting list in the case of any drop outs and will not have their form of payment charged until that time. Registrations will be taken on a first come, first serve basis. PLEASE DO NOT turn this form into your school, but send directly to the Etowah County Extension Office.
