A. Call to Order, Opening Prayer, Pledge of Allegiance

- 1. Chairman Millican called the meeting to order at 5:02 p.m. Mrs. Rita Smith led with prayer, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Chairman Millican declared a quorum present.
- 2. Chairman Millican addressed the audience about the upcoming special school tax election on May 20, 2025, emphasizing the importance of voting to renew the existing tax of 6 and 4 mills. He clarified that this is not a new tax and not an increase in taxes, but by voting yes, this will keep the tax amount the same. Chairman Millican urged the public to be vocal and educate others on the significance of voting yes to renew the tax, which will support the Gadsden City School System.

- 1. Eura Brown Elementary kindergarten teachers introduce the students who performed the Star-Spangled Banner on the bells.
- Superintendent Blackwell introduced Kiera Hampton and Mariah Ragland, members of Gadsden City High School's flag football team. Kiera and Mariah are the first players to sign a scholarship to play at the collegiate level. Kiera will attend Snead State Community College, and Mariah will attend Wallace State Community College.
- 3. Superintendent Blackwell introduced Saira Vargas and Blaze Wade for placing as State runners-up at the Alabama Skills USA Competition. Saira competed in the electrical competition and Blaze competed in the automotive competition. Saira qualified to compete in the nationals since the state winner would not be able to attend.
- 4. Eura Brown kindergarten students return to sing and play the bells to Take Me Out to the Ball Game, and they recognize Mrs. Kim Back on her retirement.
- 5. Chairman Allen Millican recognized the City Councilmen Mr. Kent Back and Mr. Steve Smith, Judge Jonathan Welch, and Circuit Judge Brynn Crain in attendance.

D. Reports

 Mrs. Marcia Farabee, the Director of Curriculum and Instruction, presented plan for the 2025 Summer Learning Experience, which will run from June 2nd to June 26th for elementary students at Adams, Floyd, and Striplin. The camps, themed "Oh, The Places You Will Go!" will operate Monday through Thursday, from 7:30 AM to 3:00 PM, focusing on literacy, math, and enrichment through activities like art, music, STEM, and PE. Breakfast and lunch will be provided, with transportation available. Students from Donehoo will attend Adams Elementary; those from Walnut Park Elementary and Mitchell will go to Floyd Elementary; and Thompson and Eura Brown students will be placed at Striplin Elementary. Currently, 265 students are registered, with more expected after ACAP reading scores are released on May 15th. An extended day option from 3:00 to 5:30 PM will offer additional enrichment through Federal Programs.

Secondary Summer School at Gadsden City High School will also run from June 2nd to June 26th, Monday through Thursday from 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM, targeting seniors for credit recovery or traditional summer school for seniors who need one class to graduate. For middle school, a skills-focused camp will be offered to 8th graders to provide one class to be promoted to 9th and 6th-7th graders who failed two classes so they can take one during summer school and the other during the school year, or if they are truant, with over 15 absences. The fee for the Summer Learning Experience for \$200.

Emma Sansom Middle will host Summer Enrichment Camps from June 2nd to June 12th for grades 6-8. Community sites like Carver, Ignite, Antioch, and the Boys and Girls Club will offer free camps for elementary students. There will also be camps for English Learners at Adams and GCHS, and a Career and Technical Education introduction program for middle-grade students during the first week of summer.
