Re-sodding of Gadsden City High School Soccer Field

Gadsden City Schools intends to re-sod the Soccer Field located at Gadsden City High School.

Gadsden City Schools will receive sealed bids for the attached specifications. All proposals must be delivered to Dr. David Asbury, no later than **Friday, August 22, 2025 at 10:00 AM** at Gadsden City Schools Central Office, 1026 Chestnut St., Gadsden, AL 35901. Bids and modifications received after that time will not be considered.

The bid opening will be held at 10:00 AM at the Gadsden City Board of Education, 1026 Chestnut St., Gadsden, AL 35901. No oral, telegraphic, email or telephone proposal modifications will be accepted. All bidders are to submit sealed bids on proposal forms furnished by Gadsden City Schools which are enclosed. Bids may be withdrawn prior to the time set for the bid opening, but may not be withdrawn after the time set for the bid opening. Bid will remain in effect for 90 days from the bid opening.

Documents required to submit with sealed bid: Bidder Response Form, Authorized Signature Form-2 pages, Gadsden City Schools Immigration Form-2 pages and e-verify proof, and Non-Collusion.

I. METHOD OF AWARD

- **A.** The award will be made in accordance with §§ 16-13B-1, et seq. of the Code of Alabama.
- B. The award will be made to the lowest responsible bidder(s) meeting requirements and specifications, provided that the bid is reasonable, and that it is in the best interest of Gadsden City Schools to accept it.
- C. Gadsden City Schools will select the lowest responsible bidder by taking into consideration the qualities of the commodities proposed to be supplied, their conformity with specifications, the purposes for which required, the terms of delivery, transportation charges, warranty, and the dates of delivery. Gadsden City Schools may also consider the bidder's past service history, past performance, serviceability of product, total cost of ownership, and experience and longevity of bidder.
- D. Gadsden City Schools reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids.
- E. Gadsden City Schools reserves the right to waive minor irregularities and/or informalities in bids.
- F. The decision of Gadsden City Schools is final.

II. PRICING

- A. All prices submitted on this bid are to be delivered prices and shall not include any state or local taxes.
- B. The bidder offers and agrees to furnish any or all items written in specifications and quantity stated on the bid and delivered with specification included.

III. QUANTITY

The district anticipates the re-sodding of one soccer field.

IV. SCHEDULE

All services must be completed between August 25, 2025 and December 31, 2025.

V. DEFAULT

A. .ANY VENDOR ISSUING ANY TYPE OF GIFT, PREMIUMS, OR OTHER TYPE OF FAVOR TO ANY EMPLOYEE OF THE GADSDEN CITY SCHOOLS SHALL CONSTITUTE GROUNDS FOR THE CANCELLATION OF THE CONTRACT AND SHALL BE EXCLUDED FROM THE MAILING LIST OF ALL PURCHASES MADE BY GADSDEN CITY SCHOOLS.

B. Where a successful bidder violates or breaches any of the terms of the contract resulting from this Invitation to Bid, Gadsden City Schools may terminate the contract at any time, and require a complete refund of all monies it has expended in accordance with the same. Gadsden City Schools may also, at any time, terminate any resulting contract for convenience and in such event, Gadsden City Schools will be responsible to the successful bidder only for the reasonable cost of any services or product already provided to Gadsden City Schools at the time of such termination.

SPECIFICATIONS

Responsibilities of successful bidder:

Soil samples to be sent off for Soil Testing & Soil Analysis Report

Flag Off, Marking & work around all irrigation to be done by Others

Three full applications of Glyphosate on the entire turf area. Applications 10-14 days apart prior to excavation & removal of existing turf. Also, apply if needed afterwards to control any bounce back.

Excavation, removal and hauling off of all existing turf material after applications & burn back from Glyphosate.

Sod cut around all edges along track, drains, irrigation, etc. Rough grading and clean up... Use of TURF SAVER MATS FOR CROSSING RUNNING TRACK for protection of surface - [NOTE. May can take fence sections down for access where possible]

Application of fertilizer & lime per soil test recommendations. Lime to be turned in at the depth of 4 inches with soil.

Deep tine aeration. Till turn top 6" of parent soil with new Topsoil & Sand mix. Laser grade to new finished elevations for sod bed preparation. Slope finish grades to all existing drain inlets & edges of running track.

*Two applications of Fall Pre-Emergent, Fertilization Post-Emerge Application after Overseed established [These treatments should carry through the end of the calendar year 2025]

IMMIGRATION FORM
