Program Services Description

Roots to Rise is a family engagement program designed to strengthen the home-school connection and equip parents and caregivers with practical tools to support student success.

Custom Toolkit

Each participating family will receive access to the digital Roots to Rise Toolkit, developed to complement the four focus areas. This resource includes literacy activities, communication guides, wellness check-ins, and future-planning tools—all designed to be accessible and easy to use at home. The toolkit reinforces learning and reflection between sessions and serves as a year-round family resource.

Community of Practice (CoP) Sessions

Participants will engage in two virtual Community of Practice (CoP) meetings, each lasting 30 minutes. These sessions provide a space for families to:

- Share experiences and strategies
- Reflect on toolkit use and program insights
- Build a support network with fellow caregivers
- Ask questions and connect informally with facilitators





Program Services Description

Roots to Rise is a family engagement program designed to strengthen the home-school connection and equip parents and caregivers with practical tools to support student success.

Interactive Workshops

Families will participate in four virtual workshops, each focused on one of the program's core pillars. Workshops are **75 to 90 minutes** and designed to be interactive, nurturing, and empowering. Each session includes:

- Practical strategies that can be applied immediately at home
- Hands-on activities using the toolkit
- Facilitated discussions to strengthen understanding and build confidence
- Opportunities to ask questions and share in a supportive environment

Roots to Rise Details



By June 2026, the program will increase the number of participating parents and quardians who report feeling confident in supporting their child's academic development by at least 30%, as measured through pre- and post-program surveys.



Program Structure

- Leveled program
 - Elementary (K-5)
- Four Workshops (2 hours each) at each level
 - Participants selected topics
 - Two virtual CoPs to support learning



Program

- Includes facilitators travel five school locations
- It does not include food or childcare for the participants

The Impact

01 Improved Academic Outcomes

Students whose parents are actively engaged in their education tend to earn higher grades, perform better on tests, have better attendance, and are more likely to graduate and pursue higher education (Henderson & Mapp, 2002).

02 Enhanced Social and Emotional Development

Engaged parents contribute to their child's improved behavior, stronger social skills, and greater emotional well-being. Parental involvement is linked to reduced behavioral problems and increased self-confidence in students.

O3 Stronger School-Family Relationships

Parent engagement programs foster trust and communication between families and schools. This partnership leads to a more supportive and inclusive school climate, benefiting all students.

04 Empowered Parents

This program will increase parents' knowledge, confidence, and ability to support learning at home.
